

Dismissals allowed by statute....

CITATION DISMISSAL

FAILURE TO MAINTAIN FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY(INSURANCE)

*You must provide a copy of a valid insurance policy that was in effect on the date and at the time that you received your citation.

*You may present a certificate of self-insurance previously issued to the driver or to the vehicle owner that was valid at the time the offense is alleged to have occurred to have your citation dismissed.

*Insurance will be verified with the issuing insurance company.

FAILURE TO PRESENT DRIVER LICENSE

*You must present to the court a valid drivers license issued prior to the date and time of the citation.

*Dismissal fee will apply.

*Copy of drivers license

EXPIRED DRIVER LICENSE

*You must present the renewed license to the court within (20) calendar days of receiving the citation.

*You must pay a \$10.00 administrative fee at the time of your request for dismissal

*Copy of drivers license

EXPIRED REGISTRATION(TEX.Trans.Code 502.407)

*Within twenty(20) days of the citation, you must present copy receipt of registration to the court. Late Registration fee must be paid to Tax office at the time of registration renewal.

*You must pay a \$10.00 administrative fee at the time of your request for dismissal(failure to pay the fee forfeits your right to a dismissal).
