

THE COUNTY COURT OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS

ORDER PROHIBITING OUTDOOR BURNING

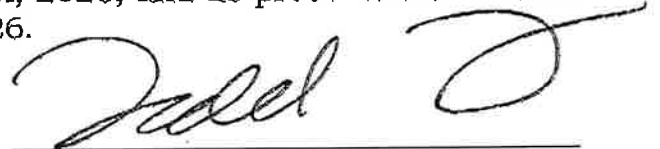
WHEREAS, the Upshur County Court finds present circumstances in all or part of the unincorporated areas of Upshur County create a public hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Upshur County Commissioner's Court that all outdoor burning is prohibited in the unincorporated areas of the county until SEPTEMBER 15, 2026, at 12:00 noon, unless the restriction is terminated earlier based on a determination made by the Texas Forest Service or further action of the Upshur County Commissioner's Court. Further, this Order may be extended by action of the Upshur County Commissioners Court had on or before SEPTEMBER 15, 2026.

This Order is adopted pursuant to Local Government Code Section 352.081, and other applicable statutes. This Order does not prohibit outdoor burning activities related to public health and safety that are authorized by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for: (1) firefighter training; (2) public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations; (3) planting or harvesting of agricultural crops; or, (4) burns that are conducted by a prescribed burn manager certified under Section 153.048, Natural Resources Code, and meet the standards of Section 153.047, Natural Resources Code.

In accordance with Local Government Code Section 352.081(h), a violation of this Order is a Class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00.

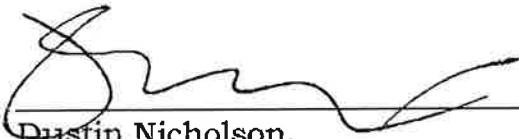
