- 6. CONSIDER AND ACT ON APPROVAL OF ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FROM GENERAL FUND CONTINGENCY FOR 25% MATCHING GRANT FUNDS FOR GILMER VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT (ENCLOSURE)

City Fire Chief, Jerry Taylor explained that this is a matching grant from the Texas Forestry Service that the Fire Department has received for over fifteen years. If the City spends \$25,000, the Texas Forestry Service matches up to \$20,000. So far, equipment acquired with this money has included a combination cutter and spreader, Jaws of Life and a thermal imaging camera. This grant also helps the ISO rating for the City. Mayor Tim Marshall asked for a motion to approve allocation of funds for the matching grant funds.

Councilman William Hornsby made a motion to approve and second made Councilman Michael Chevalier for a 7/0 vote for approval.
