Stan Hayes with Hayes Engineering & Melinda Smith with Traylor & Associates addressed Council stating that the grant application for South Montgomery qualifies for the requirement of grant program street improvement based on HUD criteria. The total cost for Montgomery Street improvements would cost \$402,500.00.

Councilmember William Hornsby made a motion to approve Resolution No. 21-008 with a second by Councilmember Marty Jordan and a vote of 5/0 for approval.




Councilmember Brian Williams made a motion to adjourn with a second by Councilmember Michael Chevalier and a vote of 5/0 for approval.
