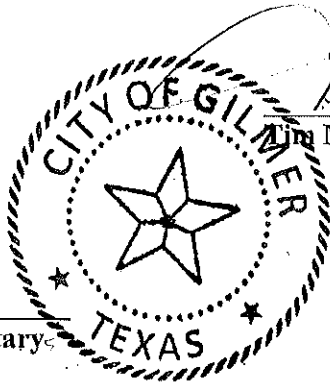


Councilmember Brian Williams made a motion to adjourn with a second by Councilmember William Hornsby and a vote of 4/0 for approval.
