**1. CALL TO ORDER
INVOCATION
ROLL CALL**

Mayor Tim Marshall called the meeting to order at 5:27 p.m. The invocation was led by Councilmember William Hornsby and Pledge of Allegiance was led by City Attorney Mike Martin.

2. CITIZEN COMMENT

Brad Roberson addressed council of the benefits of having a potential public skatepark here in Gilmer.

Councilmember William Hornsby made a motion to approve consent agenda with a second by Councilmember Michael Chevalier and a vote of 4/0 for approval.

4. CONSIDER ACCEPTANCE OF CITY INVESTMENT REPORT FOR PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2021

City Manager Greg Hutson addressed Council and stated that sales tax are up 3.52 % fiscal year to date from last fiscal year. July receipts were down 5%. Water revenue is up by 1.40 % from last fiscal year. On investment reports the 5.6 million that was deposited for park is drawing a 1% in savings acct at First National Bank.

Mayor Tim Marshall made a motion to accept city investment report with a second by Councilmember William Hornsby and a vote of 4/0 for approval.

5. CONSIDER DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION FOR THE PURCHASE OF VEHICLE FOR THE GILMER POLICE DEPARTMENT

Police Chief Mark Case addressed council and stated he found a vehicle at Sam Pack's Five Star Ford in Carrollton in the amount of \$35, 806.30 and is available now for purchase.

Councilmember Jarom Tefteller made a motion to approve purchase of new police vehicle with a second by Councilmember William Hornsby and a vote of 4/0 for approval.

6. CONSIDER DISCUSSION AND TAKE ACTION APPROVING ORDINANCE NO. 21-016 AMENDING THE CITY BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF GILMER, TEXAS FOR THE ONE YEAR PERIOD BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2020 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2021 FOR AIRPORT ENVIRONMENTAL SITE ASSESSMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,536.54

City Manager Greg Hutson addressed council and stated that an environmental site assessment of the land had to be performed in order to build any hangers in the future to prevent liabilities.
