4. HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER DEMOLITION OF OR TO OTHERWISE MAKE SAFE STRUCTURE AND LOT LOCATED AT 1508 WOODWAY

Mayor Tim Marshall opened public hearing at 5:18 p.m. Mayor Tim Marshall addressed Council regarding 1508 Woodway structure that is in unsafe conditions. Code Enforcement Fred Lawton stated that Condemnation Hearing took place on Wednesday, May 25, 2022. Condemnation Board determined that structure is unsafe and it be demolished two weeks after hearing. 

Councilmember Edwin P. Herrmann made a motion to adjourn with a second by Councilmember Michael Chevalier with a vote of 5/0 for approval.


