Spring Clean-Up March 27th – April 1st For City of Gilmer Residents

The City of Gilmer will hold spring clean-up on Monday, March 27th and Tuesday, March 28th on the east side of U.S. 271; Wednesday, March 29th and Thursday, March 30th on the west side of U.S. 271.

Residents are asked to follow the collection schedule and to place bags of leaves, brush or junk items curbside by 7 a.m. each day to ensure pick up. Items must weigh no more than 50 lbs. Brush must be bundled, cut into 3-5 ft. lengths and be no more than 12" in diameter.

Due to the large area, City residents will be limited to one (1) truckload of brush or trash per household. Please call City Hall at 903-843-2552 to arrange for pick-up.

City of Gilmer garbage customers may also take multiple loads of household garbage and brush to the old City dumpster site on March 27th, March 29th, and April 1st, 8 a.m. - 4 p.m. (only on these dates). A current <u>City of Gilmer utility bill</u> will be required to dump. The site is located on Daylily Road (off Highway 154 East).

No tires, liquids, shingles, paint cans, products containing asbestos, air conditioners, electronics, or refrigerators will be picked up or accepted at the old dumpster site.

Remember – For City Staff to pick up items at your residence, you must call City Hall at 903-843-2552 and request a pick up.
