

**RESOLUTION NO. 20-003**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GILMER, TEXAS EXTENDING THE DISASTER DECLARATION ISSUED BY MAYORIAL PROCLAMATION ON MARCH 31, 2020 IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19 A PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY; SET EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on March 31, 2020, Mayor Tim Marshall, Mayor of the City of Gilmer, Texas issued a mayoral local disaster declaration for public health emergency for the City of Gilmer, in response to help prevent and control COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 418.108 (b) of the Texas Government Code, a declaration of local disaster may not be continued or renewed for a period of more than seven days except with the consent of the governing body of the City of Gilmer, Texas.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GILMER, TEXAS.**

**SECTION 1:** The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

**SECTION 2:** The declaration of the Public Health Emergency, which was signed and executed by the Mayor on Tuesday, March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020, shall continue until such time as it is terminated by the City council of the City of Gilmer, Texas, in accordance with Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code.

**SECTION 3:** This resolution shall take effect from and after its date of adoption.


